

Year 3 - Spring 2 homework

Half Termly Tasks:

*Our topic this half term is **Predator!***

Below are some ideas of activities for your child to complete over the half term to help them engage and excel in the topic. We ask that they complete a minimum of 3 tasks, evidencing them how you wish in e.g. photos, written work or a project to share with the class.

Mathletics tasks and Spellings will also be set during this half term. Work can be submitted on class dojo or brought into school at any point during the half term, however all work must be submitted before the end of term so that it can be shared with the class.



Make a fact file or non-fiction book about your favourite predator to share with the class. Include as much information as you can.

Visit a library and borrow non-fiction books about predators. Look for information using the content's page, glossary and index. Take photographs or record any interesting facts you have learnt.

Visit a zoo or wildlife sanctuary to observe predators and prey. Alternatively, watch suitable video footage online. Choose one example of a predatory animal and another of a prey animal. Draw a labelled diagram of each animal showing the features they use to either hunt their prey or evade capture

Create a habitat for a predatory animal of your choice. Think about the location and the animals and plants that live there. Build a diorama of your predator in the habitat it lives in.

Design your own ultimate predator. What makes it stronger than others? What will it eat? Where will it live? Describe your animal.

Devise a 'What am I?' quiz. Choose a predator to research. Prepare a quiz to share with the class. This could be written or as a PowerPoint presentation.
