



### **Code of Conduct – Our Centre Rules**

We ask group leaders, as a part of our booking conditions, to agree to maintain the discipline, behaviour, and supervision of your group. We would be grateful if you could ensure that all members of your group comply with the following points for the duration of your stay at Grittleton House Adventure Centre

- We ask all groups to show consideration for all the other persons on centre, including but not exclusive to: other school groups, centre staff, any independent contractors working on site and neighbouring local residents.
- Please show respect for centre property – furniture, furnishings and equipment, and all other property. Costs for intentional damage will normally be passed on to the party responsible.
- Group members should be aware of any curfew on centre and restrict noise to a minimum during these hours.
- Smoking is not permitted in the public areas of centre, and it is strictly prohibited in all accommodation areas. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas.
- Group leaders should not allow any under-age possession or consumption of alcohol whilst on centre.
- Group members must not behave in an anti-social fashion, e.g. use offensive or insulting language, threatening behaviour or bullying.
- Any theft or other illegal activities will be reported to the police.
- No persons under 18 can leave the centre unless accompanied by a supervising adult.
- All group members must follow the country code.
- Grittleton House Adventure Centre reserves the right to send any group member(s) home for illegal activities, or consistent or gross misconduct. In such cases the cost will be totally borne by the individual or group, and no refund will be issued.
- Party Leaders must not allow children to access to any 'out of bounds' areas on centre unless specifically invited by a member of Grittleton House Adventure Centre staff.
