**All uniform needs to be named permanently**

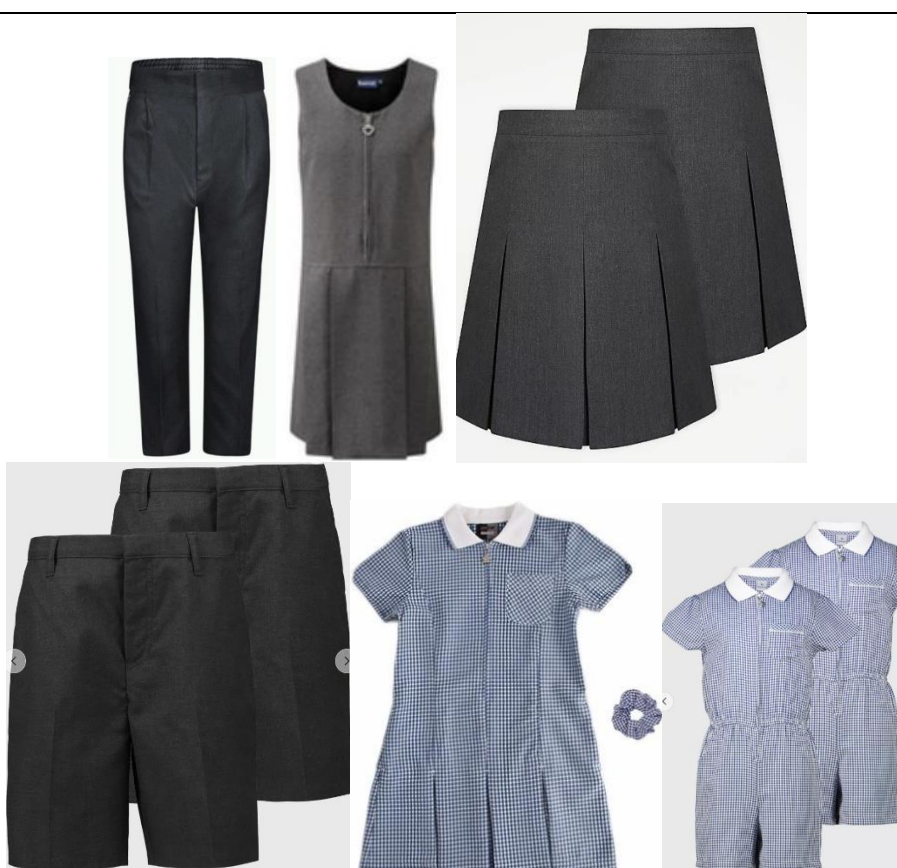
<b>EYFS</b>	
White polo shirt (logo optional)	
Navy blue V-neck sweatshirt / cardigan embroidered with school logo	
Navy blue jogging bottoms or Navy shorts	
Plain black Velcro-fastening trainers - <b>NOT shoes, the children learn through play.</b>  <b>-No flashing lights</b>	
White, grey or black socks	

<p><b>Key Stage 1 (Year 1-2)</b></p> <p>White polo shirt (all year round)</p>	
<p>Navy blue V-neck sweatshirt/cardigan embroidered with school logo</p>	
<p>Tailored charcoal grey trousers/shorts or knee length skirt/pinafore Summer term only: Summer blue dress/dress-culottes (playsuit)</p>	   

Grey/black socks (not sports/trainer socks), grey tights or alternatively white socks with summer dresses	
Plain black plain school shoes (not trainer/party shoes, no boots or sandals).	
P.E: Navy blue P.E shorts Cycling shorts (mid-thigh length) or jogging bottoms and white polo shirt (logo optional) with black or white plain trainers. Trainers: not astros/blades/ etc.	

<b>Key Stage 2 (Year 3-6)</b>	
Autumn/Spring: White shirt and school tie Summer: White polo shirt (logo optional)	
Navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan embroidered with school logo	

Tailored charcoal grey trousers/shorts or knee length skirt/pinafore  
 Summer term option: Summer dress/dress-culottes (playsuit)



Grey/black socks (not sports/trainer socks), grey tights or alternatively white socks with summer dresses



Black plain school shoes (not trainer/party shoes, no boots or sandals). Children should have Velcro shoes, unless they can independently tie their laces.



P.E: Navy blue P.E shorts or jogging bottoms. White polo shirt embroidered, with black or white trainers.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- Jewellery of **any** kind **must not** be worn in school for any reason. Please do not have any ears pierced during the school year. (Start of sum hols would be a good time to get them done so they can be withdrawn by September).
- Juniors may wear watches, but the school cannot accept responsibility for damage or loss incurred. Alarms are not permitted. Children's SMART WATCHES are permitted. Should the watch interrupt the child's learning then the matter will be discussed with parents whether it is the right time for a watch to be worn in school.
- Only Year 6 children who travel to/from school **alone** and who have a signed form are permitted to bring mobile phones (see separate walking home/mobile phone policy)
- All items of clothing and equipment must be clearly labelled with your child's name. Please check the visibility of the label regularly.
- Any queries about uniform must be addressed to the school office.



## HAIR POLICY

It is our school policy that all children wear school uniform when attending school, or when participating in a school-organised event outside normal school hours. We provide a complete list of the items needed for school uniform on our school website. Our policy on school uniform is based on the notion that school uniform:

- promotes a sense of pride in the school
- engenders a sense of community and belonging towards the school as we are all dressed in the same 'uniform' (all one) way
- is practical and smart
- identifies the children with the school
- makes children feel equal to their peers in terms of appearance
- is regarded as suitable wear for school and good value for money by parents
- is designed with health and safety in mind

All parents who send their children to our school must support the school uniform and hair policies. All parents sign an agreement on entry to our school stating that they will support all school policies including this uniform policy. Parents have a duty to send their children to school correctly dressed. One of the responsibilities of parents is to ensure that their child has the correct uniform at all times.

### **Hairstyles:**

Children are expected to come to school looking clean and smart each day. Fashion wear and styles are not part of our school uniform.

### **Please note the following school policy regarding hairstyles:**

- Hair should not be cut any shorter than a number 2 grade
- Shaven hair, hair dye and colour in hair are not permitted
- Lines shaved into the hair/eyebrows are not permitted
- Patterns shaved into the hair are not permitted
- Hair which is touching the collar or longer must be tied back at all times
- Hair should not inhibit their vision
- Hair accessories must be navy blue, white or black

Please be reminded that jewellery of any kind is not permitted in school.

Parents who continue refuse to follow the uniform/hairstyle policy **will be asked to meet and discuss the issue with the Headteacher and representatives from the Governing Board.**
