Popcorn and a drink will be included in the price, so children do not need to bring any additional snacks with them.



School uniform

Just a reminder that the children should be wearing their winter uniform. This is as follows:

Nursery & Reception: White polo shirt (school logo optional); navy blue V necked sweatshirt/cardigan with school logo; navy blue jogging bottoms; plain black Velcro fastening shoes (no flashing lights); white, grey or black socks.

Years 1 & 2: White polo shirt (school logo optional); navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan embroidered with school logo; tailored charcoal grey trousers/shorts or knee length skirt/pinafore; grey/black socks (not sports/trainer socks), grey tights; plain black plain school shoes (not trainer/party shoes, no boots or sandals). **PE kit:** Navy blue P.E shorts/cycling shorts (mid-thigh length) or jogging bottoms and white polo shirt (school logo optional) with black or white plain trainers. Trainers: not astros/blades/ etc.

Year 3 – 6: White shirt and school tie; navy blue sweatshirt/cardigan embroidered with school logo; tailored charcoal grey trousers/shorts or knee length skirt/pinafore; grey/black socks (not sports/trainer socks), grey tights; black plain school shoes (not trainer/party shoes, no boots or sandals). Children should have Velcro shoes, unless they can independently tie their laces. **PE kit:** P.E: Navy blue P.E shorts or jogging bottoms. White polo shirt embroidered (school logo optional), with black or white trainers.
